Description Global Supply Chain Management provides a first introduction to the design, organisation, and optimisation of a firm's supply chain processes, from the procurement of raw materials via production and warehousing to distribution and transportation in an international context.

Normally, a subgroup of students will be responsible for an entire session, presenting a key summary of the required literature, as well as additional material, such as other academic articles, cases, and examples.
