Goals Knowledge of the main issues in the microeconomic theory of uncertainty and information; skills in analyzing

these issues in economic models.

Description The course gives an introduction to the microeconomic theory of uncertainty and information, which studies

how uncertainty and information (e.g., about the quality of a good) affect decisions, interaction, and economic outcomes. We cover the main issues of the field, for example adverse selection and moral hazard. As applications, we study among others the decision of whether or not to take out insurance, the inference of

information from market prices, and the optimal design of job contracts.
