Description Organizational learning refers to processes involved in the discovery and application of new knowledge in organizations and to the changes in organizational repertoires, through which internal processes and external adaptation are improved. This course addresses theory and research on the complex, multi-faceted, and multi-level phenomenon that is effective organizational learning, in order to improve practical insights for consultants and managers to safeguard and improve the long-term adaptiveness of their organization. As such, this course addresses how different elements that make up an organization (structure, culture, teams, leaders, and individuals) all form factors that contribute to developing and managing a learning organization.
