Goals

Description The intention of the R&D project is to give students a real first-hand experience with research. Students will get a societally relevant research question from one of the Brightlands campuses. In order to tackle this question they will need to apply and furthermore extend the knowledge they acquired in the mandatory and elective courses. The main goal of the R&D project is not only to develop a solution for a scientific or technological problem but also to get students familiar with the scientific process behind a research project.
